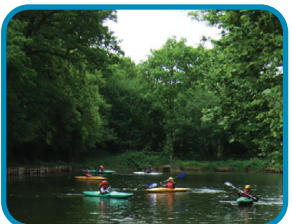

DIRECTIONS TO PIKES POOL

M5 Junction 4 – take **A38** “Bromsgrove”.
M42 Junction 1 – take **B4096** “Burcot”.
 Burcot, mini roundabout – go straight over on **Alcester Road**.
 Next right into **Pike’s Pool Lane**.
 For **Pikes Pool Centre** - entrance 250m on right.
 For **camp site** - continue for 300m then turn right.
 From **M42**, leave at Junction 1 (westbound only) then follow instructions above.

PIKES POOL



Pikes Pool is a traditional campsite and water activity centre situated within 2 miles of Blackwell Court and a short drive from both the M5 & M42 motorways.

Pikes Pool encompasses 55 acres of natural picturesque rustic woodland and open meadows offering an excellent location for all types of camping.

At the heart of the centre is the one acre pool, which is ideal for taster sessions of both rafting and kayaking.



CAMPSITE & ACTIVITIES

Pikes Pool is ideal for groups looking for the more back to basics campsite experience and up to date facilities.

A new toilet and shower block has recently been built providing services for all visitors to the centre, including wheelchair access. Toilets, wash basins and hot showers are available to all.

In addition to the new facilities on the site there are large woodland areas ideal for the more conventional activities such as survival skills, fire lighting, backwoods cooking and bivouacing.

A number of self-led activities are available including orienteering, pioneering, rifle shooting and archery along side instructor led activities such as kayaking and rafting.



THE PIKES POOL CENTRE

The **Pikes Pool Centre** is our newest facility, providing a fully equipped kitchen with fridge freezer, cooker and dining area to seat up to 32 people. It's an ideal base for weekend camping groups.

There are male and female toilets and showering facilities, which are easily accessible for people with disabilities.

The Pikes Pool Centre has its own picturesque views and an individual entrance and parking area.

There is easy access to other parts of the site and a short walk to Pikes Pool.
